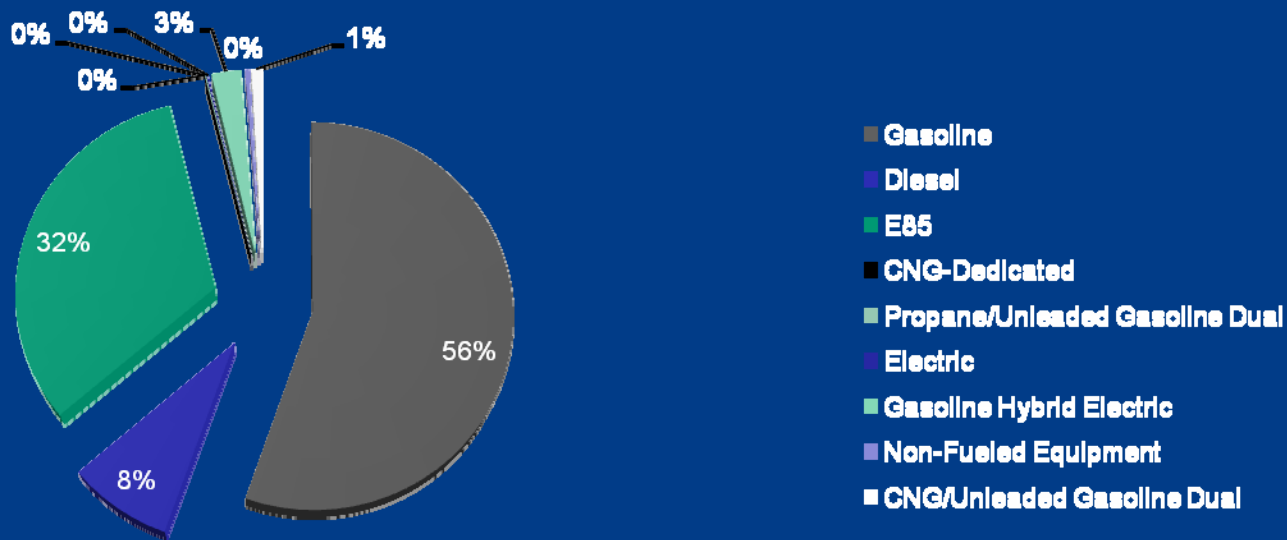
AFV FUNDING

- EPAAct 2005 requires incremental cost of AFVs to be spread across entire fleet. Leasing Agencies are assessed an AFV surcharge on every leased vehicle
- Agency HQs set the surcharge amount to be collected for AFVs based on agency acquisition goals
- Surcharge amount is adjusted as needed

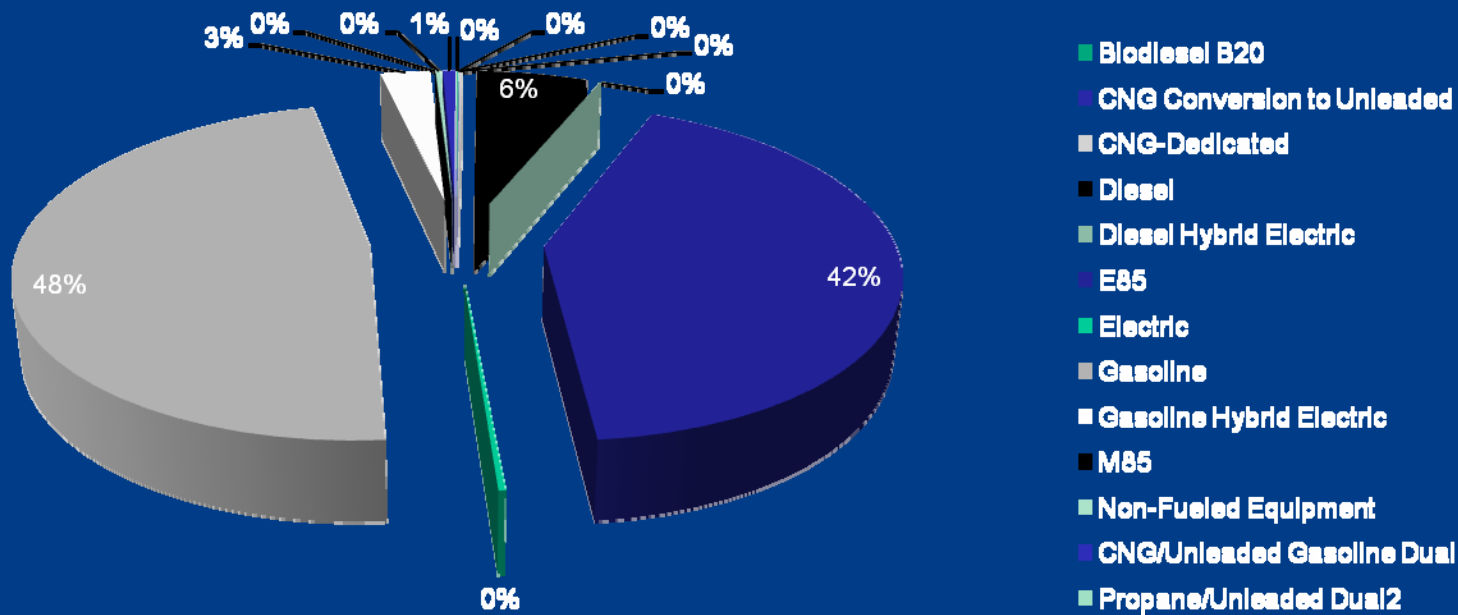

Just in... **Electric Vehicles**

- 116 PEVs purchased Nationally for pilot program
 - Chev Volt – Extended Range Sub compact Sedan
 - Nissan Leaf – Sub compact Sedan
 - Think City – Mini Compact Coupe
- For specific agencies leasing GSA Fleet vehicles, replacing existing sale eligible leased vehicles
- Expected to save 29,300 gals of petroleum & reduce GHG emissions by 260 metric tons
