Carl Tappert of Rogue Valley Sewer Services will discuss the district's recent purchase of a natural gas-powered Ford F350 pickup during a forum at noon Tuesday November 29. The forum will be held at Rogue Valley Transportation District, 3200 Crater Lake Avenue, Medford. Rogue Valley Sewer Services worked with Advanced Truck and Body in Central Point and Butler Ford in Ashland to purchase and outfit the pickup, which will be used to haul crew and equipment to work sites. The pickup is expected to be delivered in December. Also speaking at the November 29 event will be Wendel Smith of Rogue Disposal and Recycling, discussing the company's new natural gas garbage truck. The CNG truck is expected to be delivered in January and will be used in the downtown Medford route. Following the alternative fuel forum, the Rogue Valley Clean Cities Coalition Board of Directors meeting will be held, featuring a talk by Dick Pedersen, state director of the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.
